

**Emilie Gideon, née Bernheimer**  
**Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.**

Emilie (Milli) Gideon came from Fischbach near Lucerne in Switzerland where she was born on September 12th 1870. She married Elias Gideon, a cattle-dealer from Rexingen. He was a brother of Sigmund Gideon. The couple lived in Kapf, today 9 Kirchstrasse. Elias Gideon died in 1936 at the age of 70 and is buried in the cemetery in Rexingen. The Rexingen register states that Emilie Gideon moved to Frankfurt on March 31st 1942, possibly to a nursing home for the aged. However she was deported from Stuttgart to Theresienstadt.

March 13th 1943 is quoted as the date of her death in the archives of Theresienstadt.
