

Mina Krautmann, née Eichstetter
Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Mina was born in Randegg on September 22nd 1876. Her parents were Sofie Laubheimer and Samuel Eichstetter. She married Wolf Krautmann from Galicia who was employed as attendant in the synagogue in Rexingen. He died in 1937 and is buried in the Jewish cemetery there. The family lived in Ihlinger Weg, today Lichtenbergstrasse. The couple had three children: a daughter Hedwig who emigrated to Switzerland; a daughter Sarah who was deported from Munich to Riga, and a son Sally who co-founded Shavei Zion with the group from Rexingen in 1938.

Mina Krautmann was deported to Theresienstadt on September 26th 1942 and taken from there to Treblinka where she was murdered in the gas chamber.
