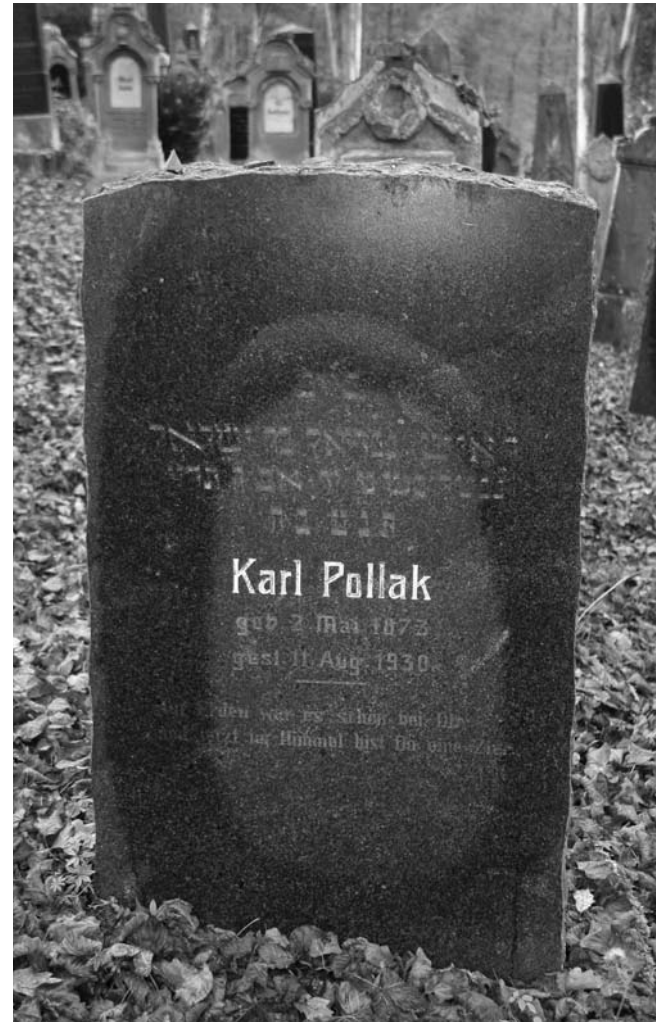


**Gertrud Pollack, née Löwenstein**  
**Deported to Riga in 1941.**

Gertrud was born in Rexingen on May 21st 1883. Her parents were Hannchen Zürndorfer and Veit Löwenstein. She had two sisters and three brothers. Leopold, the eldest, born in 1872, managed to flee to the USA in 1938. Julius died in 1925. The fate of her siblings Hedwig, Sofie and Heinrich is unknown.

Gertrud Polack was married to Karl Pollack, a cattle-dealer from Benatek in Bohemia. She was a fishmonger and the family lived in 92 Unten im Dorf, today 7 Kirchstrasse. Their son Julius was born on August 30th 1907. He later moved to Düren where he married Regina Vassen with whom he ran a leather business before they fled to the USA. Karl Pollack died on August 11th 1930 at the age of 57 and is buried in the cemetery in Rexingen.
