

**Josef and Rosalie Rothschild, née Lindner
Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.**

Rosalie Lindner was born in Affaltrach on May 19th 1876. In 1900 she married Josef Rothschild, a merchant from Eschenau near Heilbronn. Josef was born on October 17th 1873. The marriage took place in Cannstatt. The couple ran a laundry and a real estate agency in Wildunger Strasse, Bad Cannstatt.

They had one son Friedrich, born on April 4th 1901. He worked in the family business. He was deported to Riga in December 1941. His parents remained behind until they were forced to move to Schöllerstrasse in Rexingen on April 14th 1942.

Rosalie Rothschild died in Theresienstadt on October 18th 1942. Her husband died there on January 26th 1943. According to the obituary they died of “enteritis” and “decrepitude” which is the most frequently named “cause of death”. Rosalie’s brother Alfred Lindner was also in Theresienstadt at that time.

Three ‘stumbling blocks’ were laid in Bad Cannstatt for Rosalie, Josef and Friedrich Rotschild.
